Homeless Prevention (HP)

- · Housed households
- Have an income that is 100% or less of HUD'S current poverty level
- Income not sustainable
- Rent over 60% of income
- No-show 2 times for intake

Rapid Rehousing (RRH)

- · Homeless Households
- Have an income that is no more then 50% of HUD'S poverty level
- Income not sustainable
- Rent over 60% of income
- No-show 2 times for intake



Domestic Violence Shelter

- Homeless due to domestic violence, sexual assault or trafficking
- Yuba & Sutter residents (Can shelter out of county residents if there is room)
- Service or comfort animal with letter from therapist or physician
- Someone who has committed domestic violence, sexual assault or trafficking
- If someone is considered a perpetrator of above crimes Casa Staff should evaluate if eliqible



Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)

Harmony Village

- Homeless or living in inadequate housing (unsafe or unsanitary)
- 20%-50% of area median income
- Able to pay income based rent (30% of total income)
- US citizen or legal permanent resident
- Priority given to Sutter County residents who are elderly, disabled, or veterans
- Adults 18+

- Housed in adequate housing
- Income less then 20% or greater then 50% median income
- Undocumented resident
- Adults with children under 18
