

21-22 Mini Grant Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: What happens if applicants request more funds than are allocated?

A: In the event that more requests are recommended for funding than total funds available, the Commission can choose to 1) approve requests up to the allocated amount and reject any remaining; or 2) direct staff to work with the applicants to adjust their budget and award less than requested to each recommended applicant.

Q: Can I select more than one goal area or should I concentrate on just one?

A: You should select the strategic goal area that most closely matches with your project.

Q: When is the Commission meeting in October?

A: The meeting is scheduled for Thursday, October 28, 2020 at 3:30pm. An agenda and link to the meeting will be provided prior to the meeting.

Q: To clarify... the first round of applications is due by October 1st, right?

A: Yes. Applications will be accepted any time after the 8/24/2021 orientation up through the close of business on 10/1/2021 to have the opportunity to be presented at the Commission's October meeting.

Q: Do you need to spend the 75% before the reimbursement is submitted

A: Yes. Grantees cannot access the last 25% until they prove the first 75% has been appropriately utilized.

Q: May we email our application packet?

A: Yes. Please remember to sign the application.

Q: Is this also for state preschools?

A: Yes. Please consult with your director prior to applying.

Q: How do I estimate the number of families (or children) served if my business offers "drop-in" service?

A: One way to estimate the number is to review your last 6 to 12 months and see how many families you have worked with even if they only used your service once. That will give you an idea of how many different families you can expect to serve during the term of the contract.
